1. SIGNAGE

Discussed was a request by Dave Kinsey, president of the Seminole Kiwanis Club to post Kiwanis signs at the public City limits. City Council expressed interest in pursuing this request with further research done by city staff.

2. MASTER PLAN FOR THE FORMER PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING


City Manager Edmunds detailed the future plans for the public works building as part of one of the Penny for Pinellas future projects. The renovation will provide a rental community space; which will generate income, small office for community policing deputies, meeting space for the Seminole Historical Society, space for storage for the Recreation Division -- for events in the park and general space for city storage. City Council supports the renovation and master plan for reuse of the building.


3. PSTA JOINT APPOINTMENT TO THE GOVERNING BOARD
