
Mayor Johnson called the meeting to order at 8:25 p.m.

1. PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM


City Manager Edmunds introduced the City's Pavement Preservation Management Program. Each year roadways are evaluated to find out what the needs are. The City's street system includes 35 miles of paved residential miles. Public Works Director, Jeremy Hockenbury and Roadway Management (an independent third party) conducted an analysis of the current pavement conditions for the City's roadway. The data collected includes pavement condition assessment, pavement repair method recommendation and will be used to monitor, maintain and cost-effectively manage street pavements.
