**4. A CITY IDENTITY:**


Mayor Waters presented her 2015 Patriotic Spirit Proposal.

Councilor Counts left at 8:55 p.m.


Vice Mayor Barnhorn requested a second workshop. Council agreed to discuss this topic at a future workshop.
