A Workshop II of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, February 24, 2015 at 8:20 p.m. in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 – 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the workshop to order at 8:20 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Present were: Councilor Roger Edelman; Vice-Mayor Thomas Barnhorn; Mayor Leslie Waters; Councilor Chris Burke, Councilor Patricia Plantamura; Councilor James Quinn; City Manager Frank Edmunds, City Attorney John Elias and City Clerk Patty Beliveau. Councilor Bob Matthews was not present.

TOPIC: COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE.

Mayor Waters recognized City Manager Edmunds. City Manager Edmunds introduced Community Development Director Ely to explain the comprehensive plan code update.


Director Ely explained in 1989 the city created a comprehensive plan. Every 7-10 years the State of Florida requires each municipality to review their plan.

Director Ely noted that he, along with Mr. Jan Norsoph, City Planner reviewed the comprehensive plan and disposed of all redundancy; consolidated all the ordinances amending the comprehensive plan with the correct text and codified them in the proper order. It included the nine elements: Future Land Use; Transportation; Housing; Infrastructure; Coastal Management & Conservation; Recreation/Open Space; Intergovernmental Coordination; Capital Improvements and Public School Facilities.

The update to the comprehensive plan has been reviewed by the DRB. The update to the comprehensive plan will be placed in ordinance format and scheduled for the first of two public hearings. After the first public hearing, the ordinance will be transmitted to the State and other agencies for review and comment. Once the State review is complete, the ordinance will be scheduled for a second public hearing and adoption.

Mayor Waters call the workshop adjourned @ 8:34 p.m.
