

**WORKSHOP MINUTES  
SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL  
October 9, 2018**

The Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, October 9, 2018, in City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 - 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the workshop to order at 8:10 p.m.

**PRESENT:**

Mayor Leslie Waters, Vice Mayor Roger Edelman, Councilor Thom Barnhorn, Councilor Chris Burke, Councilor Bob Matthews, Councilor Jim Quinn, Councilor Trish Springer, City Manager Ann Toney-Deal, City Attorney Jay Daigneault, and City Clerk Patty Beliveau.

**1. CITY ATTORNEY AND CITY MANAGER ANNUAL EVALUATION REVIEW.**

Mayor Waters recognized Council to share their feedback on the evaluation of the City Attorney and City Manager.

Vice Mayor Edelman made a motion to postpone the City Manager's evaluation due to time constraints and clarity of the City Manager's evaluation form.

**MOTION FAILED 2 AYES (Vice Mayor Edelman and Councilor Matthews) AND 5 NAYS (Mayor Leslie Waters, Councilor Thom Barnhorn, Councilor Chris Burke, Councilor Jim Quinn, and Councilor Trish Springer).**

Council Members were given an opportunity to provide a synopsis and discuss their feedback of the City Attorney and City Manager's performance.


At the conclusion of the evaluation discussion, Mayor Waters asked that Council Members submit their respective evaluations to her and she in turn gave them to the City Clerk. Vice Mayor Edelman and Councilor Matthews indicated that they would submit their evaluation of the City Manager at a later date.


Mayor Waters recommended a 3% merit increase for the City Manager. It was noted that the 3% merit increase is what was available to all employees. It was Council consensus to award a 3% merit increase for the City Manager.
