

**MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
MARCH 13, 2012**

On March 13, 2012, the City will hold its regularly scheduled Municipal Election. Two Seminole Council seats are up for election this year for a term of three-years and 7 months. The City Council has the responsibility to appoint the City Manager and City Attorney, adopt the annual budget, and establish policy for our local government. This year, five residents have qualified as candidates to run in the 2012 Municipal Election. They are **Christopher Burke, Thomas Christy, Sheryl Goff and incumbents Patricia Plantamura and Leslie Waters.**
