WORKSHOP MINUTES SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL October 27, 2020

The Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, October 27, 2020, in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 - 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

1. CITY COUNCIL SPONSORED PROJECT FOR 50TH ANNIVERSARY

Mayor Waters explained that the purpose of the workshop was for the Council to recommend ideas of different projects that they could sponsor in recognition of the City of Seminole's 50th Anniversary Celebration.

The following ideas were given:

- 1. Murder Mystery Dinner Theater (Council would participate as characters)
- 2. Develop a 50th Anniversary Pennant with the City's logo and Council names.
- **3.** Develop a pennant recognizing the Tampa Bay Sports teams (Tampa Bay Bucs, Tampa Bay Rays, Tampa Bay Rowdies, and Tampa Bay Lightning)
- 4. Plant an Oak Tree at Waterfront Park with a commemorative plaque.
- 5. A spectacular firework display for July 4th.
- 6. Historical display of brick pavers listing City Mayors, Council, etc.
- 7. Meals on Wheels delivery by Council.
- **8.** Adopt a Seminole Nursing Home.
- 9. Plant 50 trees around the City commemorating the 50th Anniversary.
- 10. Create a time capsule which would include voluntary participation of the City Committees/Boards, to include the Seminole Historical Society, Seminole Chamber Of Commerce, Friends of the Library, Library and Recreation Teen Boards, to be displayed at the Library or the Seminole Historical Society instead of burying it.
- 11. Creation of photo album showcasing 50 years of Seminole.

It was the consensus of the Council to choose their top three (3) choices and submit to the City Manager.
