Seminole Community Library at St. Petersburg College Long Range Plan 2021-2025

GOAL

1. Enable access to, and ensure relevance of the Library's collection for community residents and St. Petersburg College (SPC) students.

OBJECTIVE

- 1) Conduct a comprehensive evaluation of acquisition and collection development policies and procedures.
 - a) Create an Annual Collection Maintenance Plan that addresses the relevancy and condition of adult materials, including a section on the SPC Collection.
 - b) Create an Annual Collection Maintenance Plan that addresses the relevancy and condition of youth materials.
- 2) Utilize the Library's self-checkout services by encouraging staff to be proactive in instructing patrons in the proper use of the equipment.
- 3) Explore the possibility of "Self-Service Holds" by patrons.
- 4) Increase promotion of the Library's digital resources.
 - a) Develop video tutorials to assist patrons with access to digital collections.
 - b) Highlight digital collections through social media and print materials.
- 5) Explore going Fine-Free through PPLC to increase access to Library materials and services to all residents.
- 6) Continue to purchase materials that are of interest to a diverse population and discusses current events and trends.
 - a) Promote featured titles through appealing material displays and book discussions.

GOAL

2. Connect with community organizations and institutions to serve as a civic focal point, bring people together, and meet the needs of the community.

OBJECTIVE

- 1) Develop a Donor Recognition Policy to acknowledge significant monetary contributions in a meaningful and consistent way.
- 2) Collaborate with SPC.
 - a) Increase the Library's presence at SPC campus events.
 - b) Participate in Program Collaboration.
 - c) Invite college faculty and other local scholars to deliver public lectures/discussions on subjects related to their respective research and teachings, topics of public concern, or general themes.
 - d) Collaborate with SPC Art Walk organizers to cultivate exhibition of artwork by local artists.
 - e) Participate in *SPC Reads* initiative by encouraging a community-wide read, providing copies of the title for check out, and holding events that coincide with the selected title.
 - f) Advertise pertinent Library events in the SPC Workshop Guide.
- 3) Enhance collaboration with the Friends of the Seminole Library, Inc., in fundraising, advocacy, and promotion of the Library.
 - Collaborate with the Friends of the Library to host an annual Friends of the Seminole Library Membership Drive.
 - b) Promote Friends of the Library awareness and membership at all programs and events.
 - c) Explore additional ways to effectively recognize donors.
 - d) Explore the possibility of creating a Junior Friends of the Seminole Library membership.
- 4) Collaborate with the City of Seminole Recreation Department.
 - a) Provide Library presence at events to promote Library resources.
 - b) Program Collaboration
 - i) Coordinate programs to eliminate duplication of City services/events/programs.
 - ii) Invite Recreation Center staff to participate in relevant Library events.
 - iii) Coordinate program scheduling to avoid calendar conflicts.
- 5) Increase Outreach Services.
 - a) Maintain and enlarge Library presence at community events.
 - b) Provide outreach services to retirement communities.
 - c) Increase outreach services to online learning and homeschool groups.
 - d) Develop and maintain relationships with other community organizations.
- 6) Encourage collaboration between the Seminole Library's Teen Advisory Board and the Seminole Recreation Teen Advisory Board.

GOAL

Evaluate Library programs and services to ensure that patrons are provided with opportunities to explore interests, engage with the Seminole community and enrich their lives.

OBJECTIVE

- 1) Enhance and showcase technological innovation and purposeful engagement of technology to learners of every generation.
 - a) Explore the installation of play activity tools in the Children's Area.
 - b) Improve Library collaboration between the City and the College for the continued use and growth of the Innovation Lab and other technological exploration and development.
 - c) Research the feasibility of offering access of college provided academic tools such as calculators, etc. to SPC students.
- 2) Prepare a well-rounded Program Plan to offer classes on a variety of subjects:
 - a) Offer Technology Instruction, Author Events, Financial Literacy & Investing, Sewing, Costume-Making and Gardening.
 - b) Offer Ask-an-Expert programs that would feature tradesmen and area specialists discussing a series of topics.
 - c) Collaborate with the Recreation Department to offer off-site Field Trips (e.g. Festival of Reading).
 - d) Investigate community interest and viability of creating a *Library of Things* collection.
 - e) Investigate the possibility of adding a Free Little Library on the Pinellas Trail in front of the Historical Society.
 - f) Highlight and promote Library programs by featuring material displays that correlate with upcoming events.
 - g) Enhance promotion of Library Services by:
 - i) Increasing social media presence
 - ii) Improving website navigation
 - iii) Developing a digital newsletter
 - iv) Creating an annual report

GOAL

4. Provide a welcoming environment that encourages reading and learning.

OBJECTIVE

- 1) Collaborate with SPC to increase Library directional signage.
- 2) Re-assess the Teen Room to determine how it could be better utilized.
- 3) Install new carpeting and vinyl flooring on the first and second floors of the Library.
- 4) Replace the lounge seating on the first and second floors of the Library (number to be determined).
- 5) Replace the chairs in the Group Study Rooms.
- 6) Complete the 2020 Interior Painting Project (specifically the children's section and staff areas).
