- 1.1 Page 1 paragraph 3: Proposals will be received by the Office of the City Clerk, 9199 113th Street North, Seminole, FL **until Wednesday, September 30, 2020 at 11:30 AM**: proposals will be publicly opened and acknowledge at City of Seminole, City Hall Council Chambers, 9199 113th Street North, Seminole, FL 33772.
- 1.2 Page 4 Playground Surfacing: Synthetic Turf (anti-static **preferred**)
- 1.3 DESCRIPTION: Questions from Pre-Proposal Meeting
 - a. Who will be responsible for demoing the current playground? **The City of Seminole Public Works staff will be responsible for removing the playground.**
 - b. Will they remove the concert footers of the playground? **Yes**
 - c. What type of lights? Do you have any spec? **As addressed at the pre-proposal meeting, lights are a requirement of the FRDPA Children's Grant. No specifications or requirements were stated in the grant only that lights are required in order to receive grant monies. As mentioned at the meeting, lighting is not the main focus of this project. We have been told some of the grant projects have something, "as simple as, security lights and other incorporate lights into the design. Both have been approved by the state." Light(s) or lighting is not the main feature of the project the equipment is.**
 - d. Will there be any trees removed? **The residents in this area love their trees and tree canopy. We do not want to remove trees if at all possible.**
 - e. Will you accept post and decks that are made out of recycled material instead of steel? **No, please follow the RFP.**
 - f. Do we need to include new surfacing sub-base material in our proposal or will there be any of the tire mulch left? **Submit your RFP as there was no base material you are starting from scratch.**
 - g. Please confirm the surfacing material. **Surface material will be synthetic turf (anti-static preferred)**
 - h. Please clarify the number of swings. **The RFP is for a total of 4 swings; 2 regular, 1 infant swing being expression type, one handicap swing.**

- i. Permitting for lights/ and permitting in general. Yes, all of your work will need to be permitted through the Building Department located at City Hall. The permit fees will be waived for this project but you will have to permit your work including lights/ electrical work.
- j. Trails/sidewalk paths. The trail on the master plan can change slightly but it meanders through the playground to help break up by ages. The RTP (Recreation Trails Program) Grant was awarded to us and requires us to put in .70 miles of trail in the park. In order for this to happen the trail will need to go on the backside of the playground as well as through as shown on the map.
- k. Can we get a CAD file? Yes, you will need to request it via email to Becky.
