Is the city part of an interlocal agreement for disposal, or can the hauler dump at any properly licensed disposal facility, if the city is part of an agreement please provide the name of the facility and the per ton cost. **Yes, for solid waste, haulers within Pinellas County must use the Pinellas county Waste to Energy Facility. The current disposal fee is \$39.75 per ton, effective October 1, 2020, is \$42.15 per ton. Recyclables can be disposed of at a facility of your choice. As stated on Pg. 14 of the RFP, each Proposer should familiarize themselves with Pinellas County's disposal facilities and rates.**
