**The Seminole Community Library at SPC is operating with reduced hours:**

### **Monday-Wednesday**

9am-11am; 12pm-3pm; 4pm-6pm

### **Thursday:**

12pm-2pm; 3pm-5pm; 6pm-8pm

### **Friday & Saturday:**

10am-12pm; 1pm-3pm

The Library will be closing periodically throughout each day for cleaning and disinfection.

**Everyone over the age of 5 entering the building must wear a mask, and have their temperature taken. This is a City of Seminole mandate.**

Practice social distancing by staying 6' apart from others not in your party.

Follow floor markings when waiting to receive staff help at any of our service desks. Limit the number of people to two at a time in each aisle.

Please do not move Library furniture as it has been arranged to allow for social distancing.

Computer sessions are limited to 60 minutes, to comply with social distancing requirements. Staff assistance is minimal due to distancing limitations.

All Library materials will be held for 24 hours before being checked in.

Meeting rooms and study rooms are closed and no reservations will be accepted.

There will be no in-person programming. Virtual programming can be found on the library's Facebook page.

The Children's area currently has no toys or games for children. Playdates, meetups and group visits are not allowed at this time.

Please return library materials in the outside book drops.

The library will temporarily continue curbside holds pick up.
