WHEREAS, City of Seminole residents are responsive to public education measures and are able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fires and medical emergencies; and


WHEREAS, Neighborhood and civic involvement in the prevention of fires and medical emergencies continue to be an important component in the partnership shared between our firefighters and our community;
