WHEREAS, the League continues to empower individuals through its many services targeted at needy families, single parents, at risk youth, the elderly and many others in need of their services; and

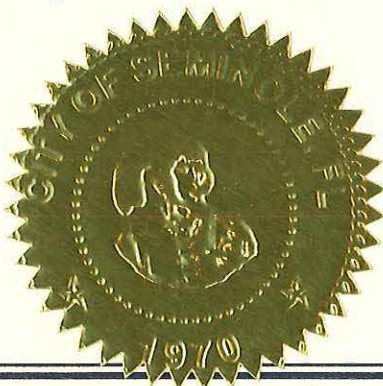
WHEREAS, the citizens of Pinellas County have come to view their Urban League as a place to turn when it appears there are no ready answers to problems that arise.
