

**WORKSHOP MINUTES  
SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL  
August 25, 2020**

The Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, August 25 2020, in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 - 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the meeting to order at 6:51 p.m.

The meeting was presented in person, as well as offered virtually via Zoom.

**PRESENT:**

**1. PENNY FOR PINELLAS IV: (2020-2029 FUNDING) PROJECT DISCUSSION**

City Manager Toney-Deal stated that this is the first of many discussions that will take place in reference to funding for Penny IV proposed projects. Pinellas County revised its 10-year estimates, due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, resulting in an estimated 6% decrease for the City of Seminole over the 10-year period; projecting Seminole to receive approximately \$24.8 million over the 10-year period.

Discussion ensued.

It was the consensus of the Council to include the following projects with the Penny IV funding:

1. Parkland Acquisition and Development.
2. Redevelopment of Blossom Lake Park.
3. Recreation Center.
4. Drainage and pre-treatment.
5. Pavement Management Plan.
6. City Hall Exterior.
7. Corridor Improvements.

It was also the consensus of the City Council to begin a Master Plan for the Recreation Center Area.

There being no further business, Mayor Waters adjourned the meeting at 7:38 p.m.
