

**WORKSHOP MINUTES
SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL
September 17, 2020**

The Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Thursday, September 17, 2020, in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 - 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the meeting to order at 7:18 P.M.

PRESENT:

Mayor Leslie Waters, Vice Mayor Chris Burke, Councilor Thom Barnhorn, Councilor Roger Edelman, Councilor Jim Olliver, Councilor Jim Quinn, Councilor Trish Springer, City Manager Ann Toney-Deal, City Attorney Jay Daigneault and City Clerk Ann Marie Mancuso.

1. CITY HALL EXTERIOR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECT.

As part of the workshop, City Council took a tour to view the condition of the exterior of the City Hall building. City Manager Toney-Deal made a suggestion of engaging services of a structural engineer to see what the cost would be to upgrade the building to a Category 4 or 5 Building. (it is currently a Category 3)

City Manager Toney-Deal recognized City Planner Jan Norsoph, to give a slide presentation of the proposed upgrades to the exterior of the City Hall building. Mr. Norsoph presented slides with two different variations of color (coral and teal), samples of signs, and upgrades to the exterior of the City Hall building. It was noted that the Miami glass will not be replaced.

Councilor Olliver inquired as to whether the City Seal above the entrance to City Hall could match the coral color in the proposed signs.

Councilor Edelman inquired as to whether the lighting and landscaping will be addressed as well. Mr. Norsoph replied that the lighting and landscaping will be included.

Vice Mayor Burke inquired as to whether the brick/stonework will be replacing the current tiles. Mr. Norsoph stated that indeed is in the plan.

City Manager Toney-Deal stated that the facade and repairs are included in the budget, however, the landscaping is not.

It was the consensus of the Council to hire a structural engineer to get an estimate on upgrading the City Hall building to a Category 4 or 5 Building.

There being no further business, Mayor Waters adjourned the meeting at 8:06 p.m.
