
DISCUSSION OF SEMINOLE YOUTH ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (SYAA) PROPERTY AND PROGRAMMING.


City Manager Toney-Deal stated that Council requested a workshop to discuss the Seminole Youth Athletic Association (SYAA) property and programming. City Manager Toney-Deal, Councilor Olliver, and Recreation Director Becky Gunter attended a Pinellas County Commission meeting where dialogue was started on what to do with the three (3) fields, SYAA, Cross Bayou, and Seminole Warhawk. The Bill to dissolve the District has been received in the Governors Office and is expected to be signed. Once signed by the Governor, the SYAA property will become the property of Pinellas County. It is the County's intention to set a millage rate for County residents in the unincorporated Seminole area, to generate revenue to support the facilities. City Manager Toney-Deal stated that at this point there is no mechanism for City involvement.

Discussion ensued.
